IN THE SHADOW OF ANFIELD

The 10th Liverpool Company celebrates it's Centenary this year having been formed in 1919 in the Parish of St Simon and St Judes Anfield Road. The Company continued throughout the Second World War but numbers were reduced through Boys being evacuated from Liverpool. In 1949 a celebration of the 30th Anniversary caused the Company to seek out former members for a reunion arising from this an Old Boys Association was formed with the Object "To foster the Christian Fellowship attained through Service in The Boys' Brigade" 70 years on this continues to this day some even meet once a month!

Throughout it's history the Company has been fortunate to maintain a strong dedicated staff enabling the Company to participate and be successful in competitions at all levels. Individuals have been prominent with two members taking part in the London Para Olympics and one as a Boxer in the 2016 Olympics.

St Simons and St Judes Church was pulled down in 1990 and the Company and Congregation were re-located to the new Christ Church facing the gates of Anfield Stadium.

There have only been five Captains throughout the history of the Company Reginald T Brisk (member of the Brigade Executive) Captain Carrathers, Peter Cuthell MBE (Battalion President) Cyril Lancaster and the present Captain David Holmes.

Displays and Shows have always had a place in the Company Programme, in 2019 the Company were honoured to have Mark Blundell Lord Lieutenant of Merseyside as Inspecting Officer. In October this year a Centenary Dinner will be in a function suite at Anfield Stadium.
