### A CENTURY OF SERVICE DESPITE ADVERSITY

On the 1st March 1918 the **Weaste Congregational Church** approved the formation of a BB Company. The first meeting was held on Friday 6th September 1918 and this began a Century of Service.

During the session 2018/19 the Company have been celebrating with several events to commemorate thier Centenary, including a Centenary Party with cake! culminating with a Centenary Camp at the District Centre this summer.

The Company prevailed during World War II all the Officers being called to the Colours, Church Officials took over and Company members were responsible for maintaining an air raid shelter in the basement of the Church!!

In 1958 the famous actor Albert Finney (who passed away on Thursday 7 February 2019) was a Bugler in the Company.

Football was high on the agenda and the Company provided 8 members in the Manchester Battalion squad of 14 for inter Battalion matches with Belfast, Oldham, Halifax and Liverpool. When the players reached the age limit a youth team was formed named *"Fives Athletic"* this title being derived from the double 5 in 55th. The team continues to this day celebrating it's 50th Anniversary in 2018.

Always innovative the 55th became the first Company to fly to Camp using Silver City Airways from Liverpool to the Isle of Man.

The 1970's saw a veritable roller coaster in the Company's history ranging from excellence in competitions and Displays to the threat of closure! In Easter of 1977 a devastating fire completely gutted the school at Weaste Congregational Church resulting in the two storey building being demolished and replaced by a car park.

The Hope High School generously made premises available on Friday evenings for Company activities and Sundays at Weaste URC, this relationship continued for thirty years, during which time the 55th maintained their excellence in competitions, particularly football, reaching several National (5 and 11 a side) semi-finals and winning two 5-a-side Finals.



In 2007 the closure of Weaste United Reformed Church threatened the continuity of the Company.

The Hope High School subsequently closed and the Company was invited to affiliate to Patricroft URC, a Church at which the 6th Manchester *(founded in 1895)* had recently closed.



The Patricroft Church warmly welcomed the 55th.

Company Captain for the past 35 years John Coates BEM writes "We look back over our history, to some it's a miracle we have survived! especially due to some of the adversities which have occurred, but if we are part of God's plan, then perhaps we should not be surprised at all. Life is all about change - Change regenerates, and should be welcomed."
