#### **OBITUARY**

**WALTER BRISK (AGE 93) -** Walter's death brought to an end a BB dynasty, the son of Reginald T. Brisk Captain of the 10th Liverpool (St Simon and St Jude, Anfield) and most energetic Battalion Vice-President. He represented the Lancashire and Cheshire District on the Brigade Executive 1949-1953.

Following his Fathers good example Walter became Leader-in-Charge of the 10th Life Boy Team. A career in teaching took him to Berkshire where he became founder Captain of the 1st Thatcham (United Reformed Church) in 1959. He served on the Brigade Junior Section Activities Committee 1964 - 1978 and was a Vice-President of the Fastern District.

Returning to Lancashire as Captain of the 2nd Rochdale (Bamford Chapel) He wrote regular a column in the Brigade Gazette under the pseudonym "Cranbourne".

He was a past President of Oldham Battalion.
