Thank you for registering on the Youth Leader Training session at Kirkham 1/2rd February.

For those coming by car to the BB Training Centre Carr Lane Kirkham (postcode PR4 3SS) there is plenty of parking at the centre. Please note that Kirkham High Street is advertised to be closed for the period of the course (see attachment). When you arrive you will be provided with a course pack including note pad and pen. Registration starts at 9.30 for a 10.00 am start. Please plan to arrive in enough time to register, pick up your pack, find your room, and have a coffee or tea.

Please try to think of a simple physical game, old or new, you can share in the games session. This session will be in the Sports Barn were you will be given the opportunity to teach your game to the other candidates and play it for a short while. You will have access to the extensive range of the district's sports equipment. If you cannot think of such a game do not panic, you will not be put on the spot.

A separate "kit list" has been included with this mailing.

Note there are two sessions, "Relationship with ..." and "Working with...." where there are two different versions that run in parallel, one for under 11s (AB/JS) and one for over 11s (CS/SS). Some only work in one age group but if you work with both you must decide which serves your leadership requirements better.

Please note the programme provided is provisional and details may change. You will be provided with the final programme in your course pack when you arrive. We will endeavour to ensure we finish no later than 16.30 on Sunday.
